



IBC COMMITTEE OVERVIEW

All IBC Committees are open for members both within and outside of the Board of Directors. With the exception of the Committee on Ethics and Appeals, committee members do not need to be certified with IBC. An application for Committee Membership must be completed (available on the IBC web site) and approved by the Board before membership.

The Committee on Ethics and Appeals investigates complaints received in accordance with the Code of Ethics, considers appeals of certification or denial of certification, and makes recommendations for final determination by the Board of Directors. Each committee member must be a certified professional with the Iowa Board of Certification. This committee meets the first Friday of each month – usually 9 times/year via conference call and 3 times/year in Des Moines.

The Committee on Finance is responsible for reviewing and recommending an annual budget, conducting in-house audits and other financial matters. This committee meets as necessary, usually monthly beginning in January through June of each year.

The Committee on Quality Improvement regularly reviews the policies and procedures of the Iowa Board of Substance Abuse Certification in order to maintain high standards. The committee as needed and/or requested by the Board.

The Committee on Professional Development and Credentialing is responsible for developing and recommending policies and procedures concerning initial certification requirements, recertification requirements, new credentials and continuing education. The committee meets monthly or less often as necessary, usually via conference call.
