Training Description:

Assessment and evaluation can feel like interviewing. It requires we ask fairly standardized questions in a formal environment, often to a perfect stranger. Our minds are bogged with requirements: what to document, how to determine credibility, is there any indication of a substance use disorder, how will they respond when I recommend treatment, what will be the outside response if I do not?

This first installment of the 6-session training series offers different approaches to assessment and evaluation. We will address why this service is provided by a trained professional and not an outline survey. We will also determine when the service is provided (hint: it isn't a one-and-done session!). Assessment and evaluation require the professional provide an environment of trust. Participants will build confidence and identify "what works" when meeting with patients for this service.
